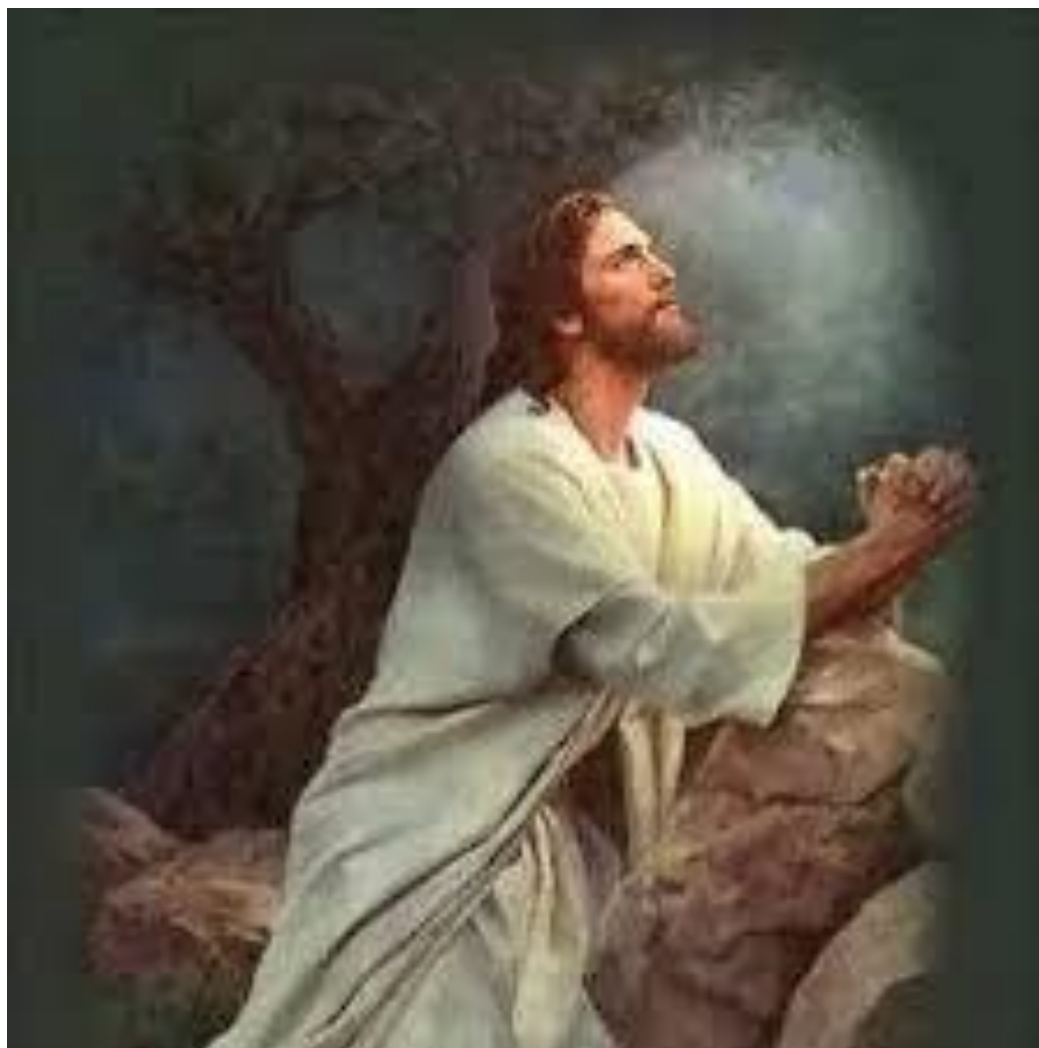


Praying Hands



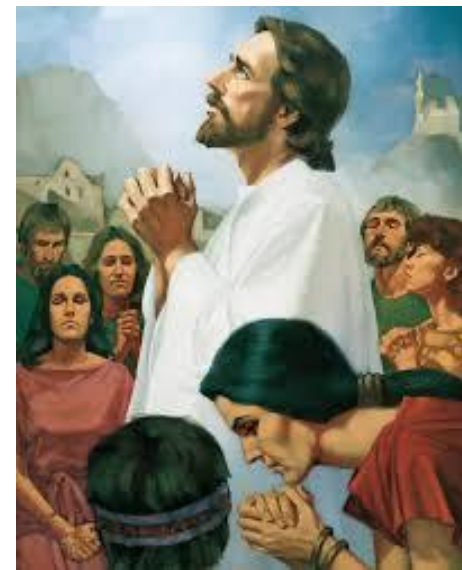
Welcome Words -

Go into the world with my peace.

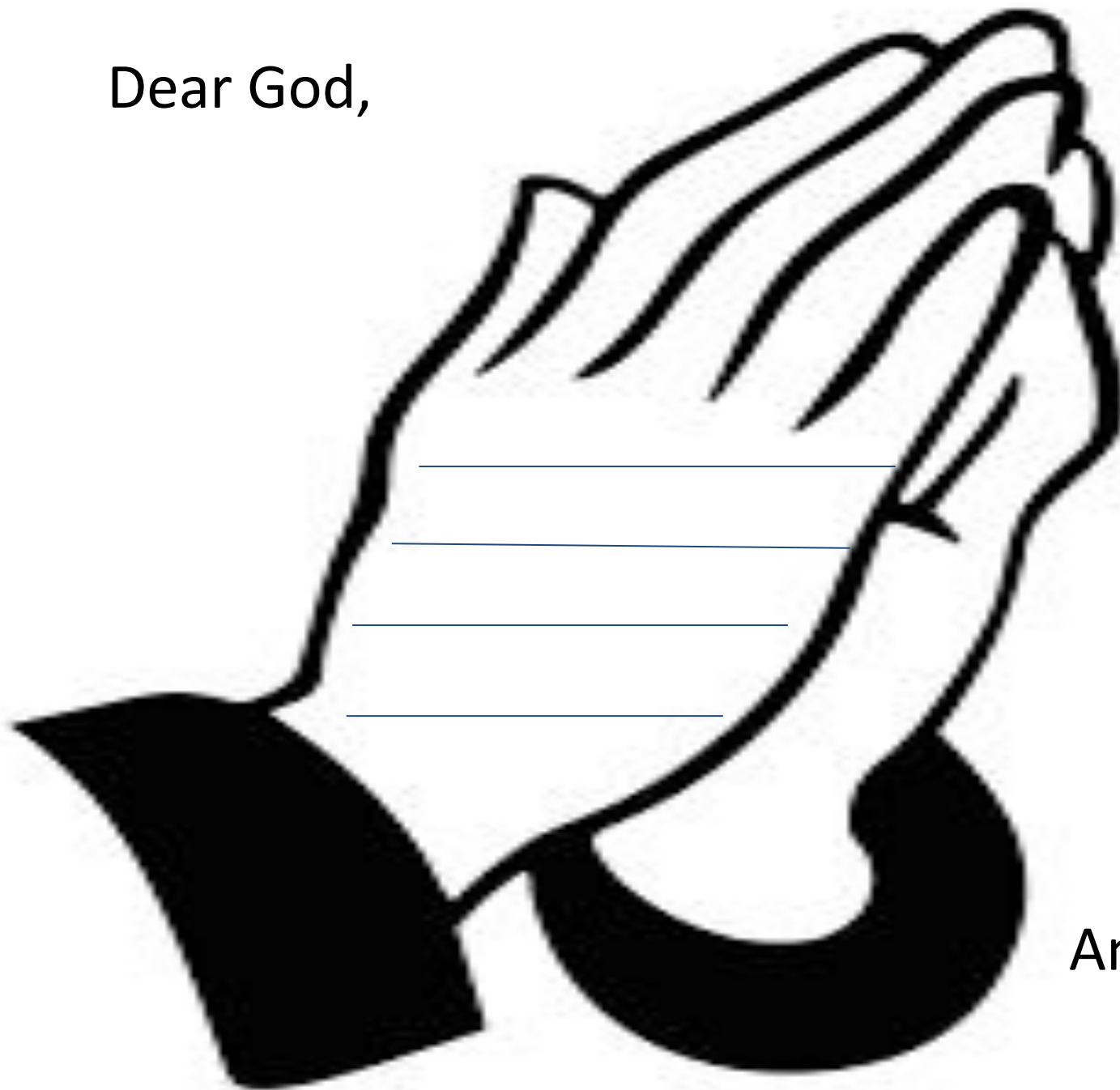
I will take your peace and love out into
